## **City of Byron Municipal Code-Swimming Pools**

**8.58.010 Private Swimming Pools.** A “private swimming pool” means a manmade rigid or semi-rigid receptacle for water having a depth at any point greater than twenty four inches, used or intended to be used for swimming, wading or bathing and constructed, installed or maintained in or above the ground, and which is used exclusively by the owner or occupant of the lot or premises in the city on which it is located, his family and his guests (Ord. 03-25 §1(part), 2003: Ord.77-10 (part), 1977).

**8.58.020 Enclosures or covers.** Every owner, purchaser under contract, lessee, tenant or licensee of a lot or premises located within the city limits upon which a private swimming pool or outdoor hot tub/spa is situated shall:

A. Maintain at all times on such lot or premises a fence completely surrounding such pool, not less than four feet in height, with no gaps or apertures other than doors or gates with any dimensions greater than six inches, except that a pool wall of four feet or more may be included in the fence height insuring four feet of protection in an above ground swimming pool, subject to the other requirements of this section. All methods of ingress and egress to said swimming pool must be locked at all times when not in use.

B. All gates or doors opening through a fence or enclosure maintained in accordance with subsection A of this section shall be equipped with self-closing and self-latching devices placed at the top of such gates or doors, and made inaccessible to small children. Such devices shall be so designed as to be capable of keeping such doors or gates securely closed at all times when not in actual use; provided, however, that the door of any dwelling forming a part of the enclosure need not be so equipped.

C. In the event that a pool wall is being used as any portion of the four-foot fence or enclosure required in subsection A of this section, the pool must also meet these requirements:

1. The pool must be equipped with a lockable ladder that shall be locked at all times the pool is not in use or a removable ladder that is removed at all times the pool is not in use;

2. The deck surrounding the pool must be equipped with a lockable gate that shall be locked at all times the pool is not in use.

D. With respect to the outdoor hot tubs/spas, the hot tub/spa must be enclosed by a fence as described in subsections A and B of this section or shall be covered with a locked lid and/or cover when not in use. (Ord. 03-25 §1(part), 2003: Ord. 02-15 §1, 2002; Ord. 02-11 §2, 5-7, 2002; Ord. 77-10 (part), 1977).
