## **About**

The City of Byron Public Works Department is responsible for the maintenance and upkeep of 16 miles of city streets that include both traffic lanes, street parking, as well as 3 city parking lots along with all regulatory signage. The Public Works Department is responsible for the maintenance and upkeep of 31 miles of water main piping, which includes 2 booster stations, 3 well sites, 3 water towers, and all city fire hydrants. Byron Public Works Department is also charged with maintenance of 20 miles of sewer system along with 5 lift stations and Byron's wastewater treatment facility. We are very proud of the City's infrastructure and work every day to keep Byron a great place to live.
